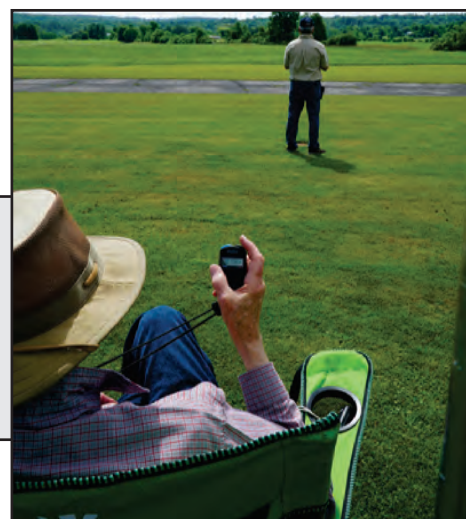


Ron Gregory Fun Fly Contest (June 21)

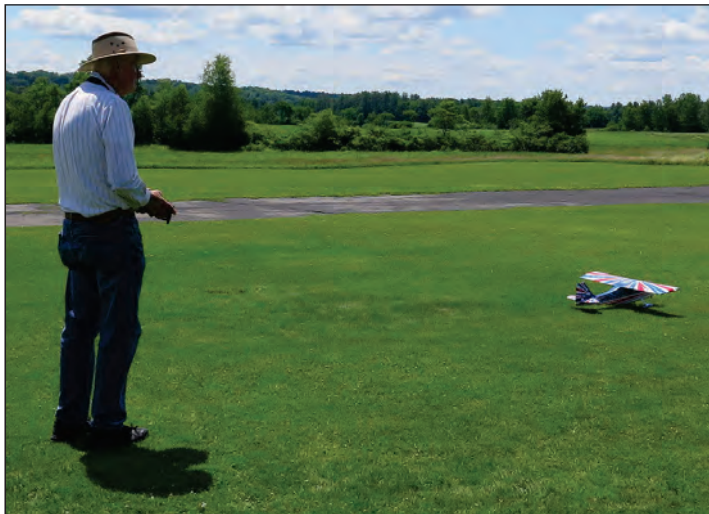
